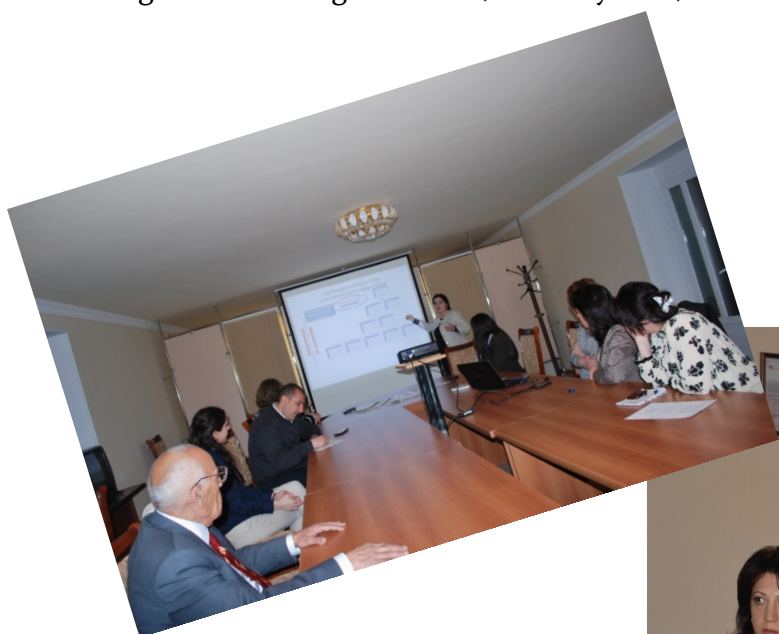


Learning outcomes, credit system
